There is a visit to Brookvale Park along the Farmington Canal Linear Park multi-use path in Hamden. The route travels 6.3 miles of the bike path going out and 4.8 miles coming back. There is a possible ice cream stop @ Wentworth's ice cream parlor near the end of the ride if that interests you.
