It then winds through the Kensington section of Berlin before visiting the extreme southwest corner of New Britain, and the Shuttle Meadow and Wassel Reservoirs in Southington. This is a mostly rolling to hilly ride with one major climb and several great down hills. The Roger's Orchards farm store makes a good lunch stop.
