22.3	Old Case Cemetery (take a break after a hilly section)
25.5	Start 5.9-mile ride on rail trail
28.7	Bridge over the Farmington River (great views – enjoy)
31.7	Begin short tour through Avon Old Farms School (beautiful campus & architecture)
33.3	Note glacial esker to left

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
