

## Scenic Tour of North Central Connecticut

Total Distance: **32.7 miles**

Elevation Gain: **767 feet**

Degree of Difficulty Index: **767 ft / 32.7 mi = 23.46 ft/mi**

Terrain: **Flat to Rolling**

Killer Hills: **None**

Geographical Region: **North Central Connecticut**

City/Town: **South Windsor**

Starting Location: **Rye Street Park, South Windsor: from Rte. 194 in South Windsor, go north on Rye Street for 1.1 miles, turn right at top of hill onto paved road at sign for Rye Street Park and Cemetery.**

Ride Description: **A scenic tour of the back roads, farmland, scenic vistas, horse farms and tobacco fields through S. Windsor, E. Windsor, Enfield, Somers and Ellington. This is a very mellow, lovely ride...one of our favorites.**

Facilities and *Points of Interest*:

0.0	Rye Street Park: Portable toilets
~5.4	Skylark Airport on the left
11.5	Top of hill and beginning of one mile ride through numerous, lovely horse farms (think Kentucky)
12.8	Dam and mill pond w/ park on the right; portable toilet at adjacent school
13.0	Somersville: Various facilities can be found along Rte. 190
17.9	Portable toilet at ball field on right
18.8+	Portable toilet just beyond CPL
25.7	Ellington Green: Convenience Store, Restaurant, Restrooms in Senior Center (ask for permission) and Ellington Library
32.7	Rye Street Park: Portable toilets

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
