It features a 2.5 mile ride through Macedonia Brook State Park (dirt road), an 8.2 mile ride along the Harlem Valley Rail Trail (good spot for a lunch stop) and a 4.2 mile dirt road ride through the Schaghticoke Indian Reservation (long ride only).
