Starting Location (detailed directions to): West Beach Parking lot in Hammonasset State Park in Madison; use I-95 Exit 62 and go south on the Hammonasset Connector to the TL; cross Rt. 1 @ the TL onto the access road into the park (there is a parking fee during the late spring, summer and early fall); continue past the toll booths to the rotary and follow signs to West Beach.

Ride Description: This is one of several routes that were developed for (possible) use during a 2009 Half Triathlon starting from Hammonasset SP. It features some significantly hilly sections while traveling inland largely on back roads w/a minimum of traffic thru No. Madison, Killingworth, Higganum & Haddam to the top of Beaver Meadow Rd. @ mile cue 29.0 --- at which point the route continues back into Killingworth, on to Chester and Clinton before returning to the starting point. For recreational riders the route provides a challenging workout w/ interesting views of some upscale neighborhoods as well as several sparsely populated and forested areas.
