

## Madison Inland & Shore Backroads

Total Distance: **29.8 miles**

Ride Description: **This ride is over mostly flat terrain in Madison with brief sorties into Killingworth, Clinton and Guilford. Meig's Point in Hammonasset State Park is a great stop for lunch. From Meig's Point the ride tours along Madison's shoreline with its outstanding views of Long Island Sound and visits the Madison Surf Club on the way back to the starting point.**
