Ride Description: This is a flat ride along the Milford and West Haven shoreline with outstanding views of L. I. Sound. After visiting West Haven's Savin Rock area (turnaround), return to the starting point. An 11.4-mile (roundtrip) option to Milford Pt. and the Audubon nature building begins at the same starting/ending location (Milford Public Library).
