

## Don's "M-K-C" Suburbia Ride

Total Distance: **30.9 miles**

Elevation Gain: **1942 feet**

Degree of Difficulty Index: **1942 ft / 30.9 mi = 62.85 ft/mi**

Terrain: **Hilly**

Killer Hills: **Several attention getters...but no monsters**

Geographical Region: **South Central Connecticut**

City/Town: **Madison**

Starting Location: **I-95 Exit 62 (Hammonasset State Park exit) in Madison (no CPL here); park beside chain link fence on Duck Hole Road (street sign)**

Ride Description: **This challenging and hilly ride passes through many nice residential areas in the towns of Madison, Killingworth and Clinton. Bring along a lunch or a heavy snack to enjoy along the route (you pick the spot). Don't underestimate this ride...we have sought out most of the hilly sections of the towns that the ride passes through. Nevertheless, although it's a difficult trek, the ride has significant redeeming value.**
