The ride travels through seldom visited sections of Madison, passes Messerschmidt Pond in Westbrook as the route heads for Pilot's Point Marina for a possible lunch or snack break. On the return the route visits Hammock Point for an unusual view of Clinton Harbor. There are many exceptional inland and shoreline views on this ride.
