The ride passes Clear Lake on the North Branford – Guilford border, and Lake Quonnipaug and Our Lady of Grace Monastery in North Guilford, before heading back down to the shoreline for a stop at Chaffinch Island Park and a later visit to Stony Creek. This ride has it all: lakes, forested areas, farmlands, views of Long Island Sound...and more.
