Ride Description: This could be called the New London College Campus ride. It passes through the middle of Mitchell College, visits Fort Trumbull State Park, and continues through downtown New London, past the United State Coast Guard Academy (see below for entry), and into the Connecticut College campus. It also features spectacular views of Long Island Sound, the Niantic and Thames Rivers from several vantage points in Niantic, Waterford and New London. A seldom used return route from New London is another highlight.

10.0	Entrance to Millstone Nuclear Power Plant (entry not permitted since 9/11 tragedy)
13.4	Start 0.8 mile tour of Seaside Regional Center (no longer operational); spectacular views
15.4	Harkness Memorial State Park (comfort station with water)
15.9	Entrance to Camp Harkness
17.9	Start of 2 1/4 mile ride along the Thames River (views) and past Mitchell College campus
20.0	Pfizer Research Center
20.8	Fort Trumbull State Park (comfort station and water available here); views
22.3	Various facilities in downtown New London
23.6+	Entrance to the United States Coast Guard Academy. With identification (a driver's license works) for each person, entrance to USCG Academy is permitted. Ask gate attendant for directions to Boat House, a fine place to view the river and enjoy a snack.
24.5	Connecticut College campus; great spot to enjoy a lunch/snack adjacent to the large lawn area
36.8	Niantic River (draw) bridge
40.5	Samuel M. Peretz Park (bathrooms)
