

Chuck's Off to Newgate Ride

Total Distance: **48.8 miles** with 40.9-mile option

Elevation Gain: **2803 feet**

Degree of Difficulty Index: **2803 ft / 48.8 mi = 57.37 ft/mi**

Terrain: **Hilly**

Killer Hills: **a few, especially Woodchuck Hill Rd @ mile 4.0; Case St. @ mile 8.5**

Geographic Region: **North Central**

City/Town: **Simsbury**

Starting Location: **Weatogue CPL, Rt. 10/202 in Simsbury about 100 yards north of Rt. 185 intersection**

Ride Description: **This is a challenging ride over rolling to hilly terrain with lots of back country road riding. Old Newgate Prison is a good stop for lunch or a break. Towns visited are Simsbury, Canton, Granby and East Granby.**

Note: The ride can be shortened by 7.9 miles by turning right onto East St at 18.9 miles and following the cues again beginning at 27.4 miles.

2.7	Convenience Store and bakery on right
2.8	Tulmeadow Farm Ice Cream on left (seasonal)
34.4	<i>Old Newgate Prison: State and/or private funding uncertain therefore facilities questionable, but picnic tables make it a nice place for a break</i>
46.2	Convenience Store and Tulmeadow Farm Ice Cream to the right on Rt. 309 in 0.1 and 0.2 mile respectively
